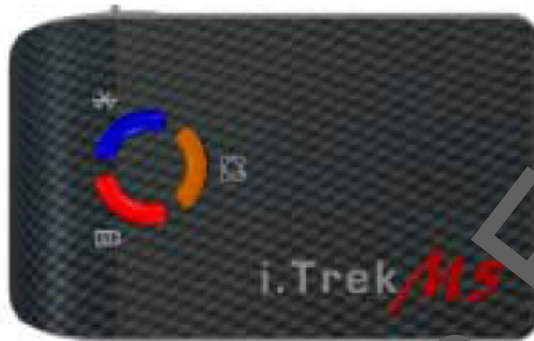

Your Trackem Plus box contains:-

- 1 x Bluetooth GPS Receiver
- 1 x 12 Month Trackem Plus Subscription
- 1 x Annual Mapping Fee (1 Year)
- 1 X USB AC Adapter
- 1 X USB Charging Cable
- 1 X Lithium Ion Battery
- 1 X Dash Mat, non-slip
- 1 X Quick Reference Card



Bluetooth LED

Solid Blue – No connection to Bluetooth device.

Flashing Slowly – Sleeping Mode (1 time / 3 sec).

Flashing Quickly – Connected to other Bluetooth device (1 time / sec).

GPS LED

Solid Orange – The GPS is searching for satellites.

Flashing Orange – The GPS position has fixed.

Battery LED

Red – The battery is low and requires charge.

Green – The battery is charging.

LED off – The battery is fully charged.

Power

On – Slide the power switch to on position.

Off – Slide the power switch to off position.

Pairing Your Bluetooth Device To Your BlackBerry

From your BlackBerry main menu:-

- Switch Bluetooth on by clicking the wheel when the Bluetooth icon is highlighted.
- The Bluetooth icon should appear in the top right corner of your BlackBerry screen to indicate Bluetooth is switched on.
- Select **options** from your main menu.
- Select **Bluetooth** from the menu.
- Ensure the GPS receiver is close to your BlackBerry and powered on.
- Click the wheel on your BlackBerry and select **Add Device**.
- The BlackBerry will search for the GPS receiver and will ask you to select the **BT GPS**. Click the wheel and the message 'Waiting For BT GPS' will appear.
- When prompted enter the PIN code for the device of 0000 (four zeros) and click the wheel. You will only have 10 seconds to do this before the device is disconnected. Once complete the message 'Pairing With BT GPS Complete' will appear.
- The Blue light on the GPS receiver will commence to flash.

Activating Your Trackem Plus Account

Goto www.trackem.ca/bluetooth from your computer to register your GPS receiver on the Trackem network.

Once installed click **run**. Goto **Set-up** and then choose **Settings**.

- Enter the phone number of your BlackBerry.
- Enter the PIN number (last 4 digits of your phone number)

Click the wheel and select **save**.

Express Evaluation

The first time you run Trackem Plus you will get the following 2 messages.

The application Trackem Plus has requested a http connection to www.ulocate.com.

Don't ask this again for:

- all http connections
- http connections to www.ulocate.com

allow this connection
deny this connection

Choose **all http connections** and then click **allow this connection**

The application Trackem Plus has requested a udp connection 64.14.66.164.

Don't ask this again for:

- all udp connections
- udp connections to 64.14.66.164

allow this connection
deny this connection

Choose **all udp connections** and then click **allow this connection.**

Troubleshooting

Why am I not getting a flashing orange light on the GPS receiver?

- Ensure the GPS receiver has a good line of sight to the sky.
- Try re-starting Trackem Plus.
- Ensure the GPS receiver has not got a low battery.

How do I know that the GPS receiver is paired to my BlackBerry?

- The blue light on the GPS receiver will be flashing once per second.

I've paired my device; but am still not getting the Bluetooth connection.

- Ensure your GPS receiver is a reasonable distance from your BlackBerry.
- Ensure Bluetooth is switched **on** from your main menu on the BlackBerry.

How do I know that I have a GPS fix?

- The orange light on the GPS receiver will be flashing.
